This letter serves as a formal notice that your delinquent debt has been officially turned over to the Louisiana Office of Debt Recovery (ODR) for collection. As a result of this referral, ODR has added a collection fee of 25% to your previous debt balance. Your current debt balance is shown above.

Payment in full is due immediately. If full payment is not received, ODR is permitted by state law to use any collection tools necessary, including but not limited to: levying or seizing your bank accounts, garnishing your wages, offsetting your state tax refund, offsetting your federal and/or state vendor payments, suspending your driver's license, and/or hunting and fishing licenses and recommendation to suspend professional licenses. A list of Louisiana Statutes pertaining to the setup of ODR and the use of these tools is listed on the back of the page.

There is a complete list of payment methods for OMV debt listed on the back of this letter. If making a payment in person, please bring this letter with you. In addition to payment, there may be OMV compliance documentation needed to clear an OMV suspension and/or revocation. For further information, you can check your driver license status at www.expresslane.org or you may contact OMV directly at 225-925-6146.

Please note: Money collected through the use of offsets as well as payments sent directly to ODR, may take up to 60 days to reflect on your debt balance shown in the OMV system. Immediate clearance of your driver's license due to a DPS debt will require a full payment of your debt balance as shown in the OMV system. OMV will refund any overpayment to you once the balance reconciliations between the data systems at OMV and ODR are complete. All funds collected by OMV will be credited on your account with ODR.
